Wishing everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year for 2025!



Rationale – As Hills Dog Club Inc now runs Trick Competitions we need to introduce Perpetual Trophies for our members.

All calendar award time frames run from January 1^{π} to December 31^{π} . Starters and Novice run over 2 years.

TRICK DOG PERPETUAL TROPHIES CRITERIA

Trick Dog Starter Trophy

Criteria – Highest scoring dog out of 3 passes within the last 2 years.

Rationale: Because dogs can only get 3 passes this allows them to have 2 years to get the scores.

Trick Dog Novice Trophy

Criteria - Highest scoring dog out of 5 passes within the last 2 years.

Rationale: Because dogs can only get 5 passes this allows them to have 2 years to get the scores.

Trick Dog Intermediate Trophy

Criteria - Highest scoring dog out of 5 passes within the last 2 years.

There is no limit on the number of passes a competitor can achieve thus allowing them to pick their 5 highest scores.

Trick Dog Advanced Trophy

Criteria – Highest scoring dog out of 5 passes within the last 2 years.

There is no limit on the number of passes a competitor can achieve thus allowing them to pick their 5 highest scores.

RATIONALE – Starters and Novice have been based on our current criteria for Rally Novice, CCD and CD and applied because once a dog has the required number of passes it must proceed to the next level. Intermediate and Advanced have been based on our criteria for Open and above, Rally Advanced, and above as you may continue to compete in these classes indefinitely, so can accumulate more than the required 5 passes and pick your best results.

Ground Rules

- 1. **Vaccinations**: As a condition of membership, all dogs are required to be properly vaccinated according to current veterinary guidelines.
- 2. **Dog Behaviour:** Members are responsible at all times for the behaviour of their dog/s whilst present on the training grounds or representing the club.
- 3. **Appropriate Equipment:** All dogs must have properly fitted equipment and remain on lead at all times (unless instructed otherwise by a club instructor). No check/choker chains are to be used on any dogs in Puppy, Beginners or Graduate classes.
- 4. **No Ill-treatment:** A member shall not ill-treat a dog at any time. Any such action may give rise to suspension or expulsion from the Club by resolution of the Committee.
- 5. **Bitches in Season:** Bitches in season and/or dog/s which are unwell or have an infectious condition are not permitted on the obedience training grounds.
- 7. **Clean up after Dogs:** Members are to pick up after their dog/s and help keep the grounds clean and tidy.
- 7. **Sensible Footwear/Clothing:** Adequate sensible dress with appropriate footwear (no thongs, scuffs on bare feet) is required to be worn by handlers during training.
- 8. **Supervision Required:** Dogs are not to be left unattended whilst on the training grounds unless crated or tethered in a safe area. Members are reminded not to approach dogs that are confined. All dogs are to be kept under control and supervised while at the counter or in the clubhouse.
- 9. **Muzzles**: The Club reserves the right to ask any member to muzzle or in extreme cases, remove their dog/s from the training grounds. If a muzzle is required, this must remain in place whilst on the club grounds. This will be at the discretion of the Committee.

- 10. **Club Equipment Use**: Members who use Club equipment must ensure it is returned to the storeroom and stored correctly after classes are conducted.
- 11. **Child/Junior Handlers:** Children are welcome to attend classes provided they are supervised by an adult/parent/ quardian at all times.
- 12. **Child Members:** Child members (aged 7 to 11 are to be accompanied by an adult/parent/guardian in classes). Junior members (aged 12 to 15 under adult/parent/guardian supervision on grounds) are welcome to train provided they have sufficient control of their dog during classes. This will be at the discretion of the class/chief instructor.

HDC Awards Criteria



CHANGES to CRITERIA for ALL HILLS DOG CLUB INC. AWARDS

*** * * * * * * * * * * * * * * * ***



There have been some important changes to <u>all</u> Hills Dog Club Inc. awards criteria this year. It is important that you read and understand these forms before submitting your entries.

Please note:

Entries will close on Tuesday 11⁵¹ February 2025. No late entries will be accepted – please do not ask for an extension.

Entries should be posted to The Secretary, Hills Dog Club Inc., PO Box 392, Round Corner, NSW, 2158 <u>or</u> handed to Carole Hately at the Club at Monday night or Tuesday morning training.

Recipients of awards and trophies will need to attend the Hills Dog Club Inc. AGM on the Wednesday 19th March 2025 to collect their awards.

Please read the new criteria for all Obedience & Rally levels, and for the Iris Bollinger Memorial Trophy and the new Iris Bollinger Novice Memorial Trophy. We will have new Tricks and Scentwork Perpetual trophies, Criteria will be available after December General Meeting.

Please note that the Dianne Atkins Perpetual Trophy for Highest Achievement in Canine Competition will be awarded only to competitors in ANKC approved dog sports.

In the past, we have permitted qualifying certificates to be viewed and verified at the office. This will no longer be the case. From now on, photocopies of relevant documentation must be attached to your application. Applications via email or phone will not be accepted.

Please make sure your application for Obedience & Rally Awards, Tricks and Scentwork Trophies, (point score awards) has copies of the qualifying cards attached.

When applying for Title Trophies you must attach a copy of the updated Title Certificate issued by ANKC. Breeder's certificates will not be accepted.

When completing paperwork, please write your dog's name <u>including</u> any titles you wish to appear before or after your dog's name.

Finally, because of the number of pages required to print all the information about Hills' awards, this will not appear in *Howler*. To view the full documentation, and to print application forms, please go to our website www.hillsdogclub.com OR the files section on the members fo page...

We believe these new rules are more consistent across all awards and trophies and will make the application process easier for handlers.

Thank you for your patience while we introduce the changes. Hopefully the transition will be smooth!
